The mission of the Cook Inlet Regional Citizens Advisory Council is to represent the citizens of Cook Inlet in promoting environmentally safe marine transportation and oil facility operations in Cook Inlet.

We have reviewed the proposed amendments to 18 AAC 75 to remove the non-tank vessel equivalent plan option from Alaska's spill response preparedness regulations. Since all operators to date have opted for the streamlined plan option using a primary response action contractor (PRAC), rather than to develop their own plans, it is not necessary to retain the latter option in the regulations. We agree that this is an appropriate revision, and one that ultimately improves clarity for regulated operators by removing unnecessary language.
